ammonia can also
act as a storage

medium for hydrogen enabling it to be transported over longer distances more easily ammonia is found in very small amounts in some foods including vegetables and dairy products it is also produced naturally in the human body by gut bacteria as they break down food ammonia is a chemical found in trace quantities on earth being produced from nitrogenous animal and vegetable matter ammonia and ammonium salts are also found in small quantities in rainwater whereas ammonium chloride sal ammoniac and ammonium sulfate are found in volcanic districts 14
